## PRESIDENT'S LETTER



The 50<sup>th</sup> Annual Texas State Federation festival in Wichita Falls was enjoyed by 565 attendees, including a good contingency of HSRDC members, participating in all types of dance, enjoying the "Walk Down Memory Lane" fashion show, ice cream after parties, and shopping, of course. The festival featured a variety of excellent callers and cuers, including some of our own. Teen scholarship winners were announced, and two of the fourteen recipients were from HSRDC: Steven Camara of the Brazos Bottoms Belles & Beaus, and Erin Teague, El Campo Cotton Squares. There were also winners from the Grand Squares youth club that dances in Tomball and often visits our events. The scholarships awarded were in the amount of \$1500.

At the business meeting we were able to present, for the Teen Scholarship Fund, checks totaling \$3,750.62, reflecting substantial donations by Bluebonnets, Katy Prairie Promenaders, and Hey Lollies, as well as other club & individual donations and from the HSRDC Trade 'n' Buy. This brings the total given by HSRDC thus far in 2012 to \$4,734.62. Also, the 2014 Conclave meeting was awarded to Houston and the tentative location for the meeting is in Katy.

As we write this letter we are getting ready for the National Convention in Spokane. HSRDC will have a table there, and quite a few of us will be on hand to support the 2016 National Convention bid for Amarillo.

## Thanks for the Memories!

From

### Pat & Kim Barbour

In 1969 at the age of 15, his brother and sister in-law introduced Pat to square dancing in Houston, TX (which is where he was born and lived most of his life). It was the typical initial reaction that most people (especially males) have to square dancing when first invited to watch. Pat was so emphatic that he would not be interested, that his brother had to bribe him financially to come and try it. Once Pat took the floor of the local teen club (Texas Twirlers) and heard the music, he knew he was hooked. The following year (1970) he started calling lessons under the tutelage of Red Donaghee and Jim Hale. This is also when Pat would meet (what would turn out to be his lifelong best friend) Bob Baier. Square dancing soon consumed Pat's life. The majority of his spare time when not in school or working was spent either dancing or calling square dances. In 1975 at a festival he was calling in Carmine, TX (The Bloomed Out Bluebonnet Festival), he would meet and fall in love with his future wife Kim. They married in 1980 at which time Pat decided that it was time for him to take the leap and become a full time square dance caller. He had a multiple workshop clubs called the Barbour Shoppers all over Texas. At the peak of the square dance boom (early 1980s), Pat had over 800 couples state wide in the Barbour Shoppers and he would make weekly trips to Lubbock, Midland, Hobbs NM, Big Spring and Ft. Worth. He was also traveling across the US and other countries calling at resorts and Square Dance Festivals. Pat has called in most all the 50 United States including Alaska and Hawaii as well as Canada, Sweden and Japan. In 1985 Pat's life would take another turn when his first son Patrick, Jr. was born. It was time for him to make a decision about remaining a full time caller or returning to the workforce and helping raise his family. He chose the latter. His family grew again in 1990 with the arrival of his son Austin.

Pat has recorded over 100 Square Dance Singing and Patter calls. He was the first caller to join Wade Driver on Rhythm Records and in 1988 with the encouragement of his good friend Mac O'Jima from Sendai Japan, he started Elite Records. Pat has had the great fortune of forging a lifelong friendship with the Japanese Square dancers and has made over 25 trips to Japan to do festivals since 1983. He has also enjoyed many square dance vacations with Mac & Meg O'Jima and the Japanese square dancers. Pat's final dance in December 2012 will be in Japan celebrating his retirement and the 50th anniversary of Mac O'Jima's calling career.

Pat has been blessed over the years with many great friends in the square dance world and feels incredibly fortunate to have been introduced to this fabulous past time over 42 years ago. While he and Kim plan to retire from calling, they still plan to dance and enjoy the activity that has meant so much to them over all these years.

## **Dancing Right**

This month's subject is **Courtesy Turn**. A **Courtesy Turn** is mainly used to define and teach calls like Ladies Chain, Chain Down the Line, Right and Left Thru, DoPaso and Eight Chain Thru. It can also be used as a call by itself.

**DEFINITION**: A couple works as a unit and turns around with the left-side dancer or "Beau" (most of the time the man) backing up and the right-side dancer or "Belle" (most of the time the lady) walking forward. The pivot or turning point is halfway between the two dancers. Facing dancers blend into a normal couple as they perform a **Courtesy Turn**. The amount of turning is determined by the following rules or may be given explicitly. If the rules are contradictory or none apply then the amount must be given explicitly.

- 1. A couple that has other dancers behind them turns 180 degrees to end facing those other dancers.
- 2. Dancers working on the outside of the set turn to end facing the center of the set.
- 3. If an inactive outside man is facing in with an active lady coming toward him, the couple turns to face the direction in which the inactive man had been facing.

Ending formation is couples facing in to their group of four or to the center of the set.

DISCUSSION: Timing for *Courtesy Turn* is 4 beats. The call *And A Quarter More* can be used after a *Courtesy Turn* or a call ending with *Courtesy Turn* (e.g. *Right And Left Thru And A Quarter More*). The couple turns an extra 90 degrees, generally ending in a right -hand two-faced line. The turning amount can be given explicitly either by the final facing direction (e.g. *to face back in*) or the total distance, or both (e.g. *Centers go a full turn around to face the outside two*). *Courtesy Turn* can also be called from positions other than a couple. One example could be where the ladies are turning a right hand star and the caller could say *Men reach in and Courtesy Turn your original corner*. In this case the *Courtesy Turn* itself is going to be more than a 180 degree turn. You need to finish the *Courtesy Turn* with whatever amount of a turn is necessary to end facing toward the center of the set. Please remember that an *Eight Chain Thru* or fractions thereof have a *Courtesy Turn* when you get to the outside of the square and not just a left hand pull by!

**STYLING**: I want to reiterate my views on making square dancing pretty and stylish. I regard the female gender as 100% feminine, dainty, lovely to look at, and needing all the tender handling they can get. I like ladies to dance like ladies, with class and grace. Uhh, well, most of the time.

What to do with your left hands: The man's left hand, **palm up**, and lady's left hand, **palm down**, are joined. <u>Please read the previous sentence again and again</u>! Ladies, please don't give the man your left hand palm up in a **Courtesy Turn**. Personally, I will not accommodate you. I will extend my hand to you palm up as I should and gently turn your hand over. I have more control of your balance with my left palm up and under your left hand palm down should you lose your balance and start to fall. Men, if the lady extends her left hand to you palm up gently turn her hand over so that you can give her all the support you can while dancing.

What to do with your right hands: Right hands are placed according to the lady's choice. If she places her right hand behind her right hip, palm out, then the man places his right hand in hers without grasping it, leaving these hands available for the next call. If she uses her right hand to work her skirt or simply allows her right arm to hang naturally, then the man places his right hand in the small of her back.



## **HEARING ASSIST UNITS**

A number of clubs, callers and cuers are using hearing-assist systems. These systems consist of a transmitter that's hooked up to the sound system and receivers with ear-bud or ear-speaker worn by dancers. Dancers can purchase the receiver for around \$100.00 to \$160.00 depending on the model. The caller/cuer typically transmits voice signal (this is what most dancers who are hearing-impaired have trouble picking up).

An assistive listening system makes a wireless, electronic connection between the sound source and your ear. This "bridging" effect eliminates the effects of distance, background noise and reverberation so that you can hear and understand better; it's like having the sound source right next to you. If you are in the back of the room, the sound volume can be adjusted at your ear to be as loud as you want, without increasing the loudness of the background noise in the room. Even if the room is noisy or very reverberant, you should still be able to hear clearly, since the listening system is bypassing all the acoustical conditions in the room.

Your electronic ad needs to be the same size as your print ad. We are reproducing the print version of the Where N When, but adding color, hyperlinks, searchable text, etc.

The ads for the electronic version do not have to match the print version in content, you can add graphics, photographs and color to the electronic version of the ad.

You can submit any kind of graphic file (.gif, .jpg, .wmf, etc.) or you can submit a document (.doc, .docx) file.

Photographs are permitted, but keep in mind that the file size (the number of bytes (KB or MB)) should be reduced. Larger files mean slower loading times. Picasa is a free photo editing application that you can use to reduce file size for photographs.

To maintain the quality of the print version of the WnW, your camera ready ad for the print version should be submitted in black and white to <u>Mary Pickens</u> at <u>marypick-</u> <u>ens 1@sbcglobal.net</u>. The print version will continue to be produced in black and white. Your ad for the on-line version of the WnW, with color and graphics should be submitted to <u>Susan Pittman</u> at stpittman@comcast.net.
