

This was the first festival held in the Astroarena, and it was very successful. Lem Gravelle was the caller. During their term of office, the format of the Council Newsletter was changed from a single page to the current format.

Nominations will be individually written, giving examples of the nominee's service, support and specific acts which qualify him/her to receive the award. Nominations will be sent to the President. The President will send copies of all nominations to members of the Executive Board, and all prior recipients of the award, along with a ballot to be returned to the President with each person's choice. All ballots will be tabulated by the President and 1st Vice President, and the President will announce and present the winners with the award plaque at the Hoedown.

CALLER/CUER OF THE YEAR AWARD

The President will invite members of the square and round dance community to nominate caller/cuers they feel have been exemplary in their endeavors to promote and enhance square and round dancing in the *current year*. Nominations will be individually written, giving examples of the nominee's service, support and specific acts which qualify him/her to receive the award. Nominations will be sent to the President. HSRDC Policy Manual -9-5/2009The President will send copies of all nominations to members of the Executive Board and all prior recipients of the award, along with a ballot to be returned to the President with each person's choice. All ballots will be tabulated by the President and 1st Vice President, and the President will announce and present the winners with the award plaque at the Hoedown.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Lifetime Achievement Award may be awarded at any time during the calendar year to a couple, individual or caller/cuer who has shown <u>20+ years</u> of service to the square, round and clogging dancers of greater Houston. Nominations are welcome at any time and requires a unanimous vote of the Executive Board. Awards maybe presented at any major dance within any member organization of the Council.

HSRDC OFFICES IN REVIEW

The Camping Coordinator works with local clubs when asked to arrange camping facilities for local dances, inform HSRDC members about camping facilities for the State Festival and the National Convention, serves as a Wagon Master for the HSRDC Hoe Down, and is available with information for the State Camping Coordinator of camping facilities for HSRDC dances. Brice and Debbie Hesche serve as the 2013 Camping Coordinator.



The Texas State Federation of Square and Round Dance (TSFSRD) Membership Chairman is responsible for submitting a list of dancers of the clubs in the Houston Square and Round Dance Council to the TSFSRD for insurance purposes. This is the list of membership that is required from each club in July and December. This position does not always change each year. Troy and Bridgett Brown serve as the 2013 HSRDC TSFSRD Membership Chairman.

The Parliamentarian of HSRDC makes sure Robert Rules of Order are followed at all Council meetings, the By Laws and Policy Manual and Rules of Order are followed throughout the year. A strong knowledge of Robert Rules of Order and HSRDC Bylaws, Policy Manual and Rules of Order are required to fulfill this position. This is a position that does not change often. Gaylene Bynum serves as the 2013 HSRDC Parliamentarian.

The Teen and Youth Liaison promotes interest in square dancing among the youth and serves as a mentor and advisor for youth dancers. This office also promotes youth participation in Council functions. This position requires much energy and interest in working with the youth. K.O. Jeanes and La Nelle Jeanes serve as the 2013 Teen and Youth Liaison.



The Hospitality Directors are responsible for refreshments at all Council meetings and HSRDC sponsored events. These can include any orientation, leadership seminars, the Hoe Down and State Federation HSRDC sponsored Hospitality rooms and after parties. This position is also responsible for any equipment that may be needed to function at this job...coffee pots, water, ice coolers and etc. Robert and Karen Hlavinka serve as the 2013 Hospitality Directors.

STATE FESTIVAL 2016—WHY WACO?

Texas Federation of Square and Round Dancers asked Houston Square and Round Dance Council to consider hosting the 2016 State Festival. The last State Festival hosted by HSRDC was June 2010 at the Galveston Convention Center. The 2015 Festival will be at the Waco Convention Center. Waco guaranteed the same price if we held the convention there in 2016 as well.

At the May 11, 2013, HSRDC meeting, a motion was made for HSRDC to be the host for the 2016 State Festival and the motion was passed. It was also determined that a committee would be formed to conduct a search of the existing venues in the Houston area and see if we could hold the dance in the greater metropolitan Houston area. The committee members are: Lewis and Marilyn Chumbley, Secretary of TSFSRD (and president-elect for 2016), Bruce Behrens and Roxie Walker, President of HSRDC, Jim and Dee Stephens, past president of HSRDC (and president when the last state festival was held in Galveston) and Darrell & Susan Pittman.

We looked at many options and received bids from many venues in and around the Houston area. The two most promising and reasonably priced were Lone Star Convention Center in Conroe

and Moody Gardens in Galveston. We also received bids from hotels in the area, such as the Greenway Doubletree (formerly the Renaissance), the Woodlands Inn and Conference Center and the Marriott Westchase. Because June is wedding season, and because hotels can get up to \$10,000 for a ballroom per night, they were not interested in accommodating our request for 6 dance rooms, plus other rooms at a price that TSFSRD can afford and to further complicate matters, flooring would have to be rented, as most of these facilities are carpeted. Reliant Center gave us a bid, which was considerably more than TSFSRD could pay and complications such as parking, ruled Reliant out as a venue. The George R. Brown said they would not consider renting to us until about a year away from the event. It seemed they were hoping to hook a bigger fish and didn't want to be tied to a



small contract. Other venues we looked at were Merrell Center in Katy and Berry Center in Cypress. Both of those facilities are unavailable the first three weeks in June of any year.

The Lone Star Convention Center in Conroe is slightly on the small side for the State Festival, but we could have made it work. Some of the rooms have carpeting, but we could have made that work as well. The biggest problem with Conroe was the lack of convenient hotel rooms and the total absence of camping facilities. The facilities are there, but they are booked with other annual events, since that is a resort area. Given these issues and the fact that their price was slightly more than Waco, we ruled them out as a possibility.

Moody Gardens delivered a reasonably priced bid for the dance facilities, but there was a catch. They wanted a guarantee of 300 rooms for the weekend at \$199.00 per night (summer season rates). As a group, we decided that the room price was not in line with what dancers were willing to pay per night. Other hotels in the area are also much more expensive than they are in November, when we generally have Hoedown. Also, that time of year on the island can get very crowded, as it is the height of vacation season. Overall, as a committee, we decided that Moody Gardens was not a viable solution.

That brings us back to Waco for 2016. The facility is a good size and will comfortably accommodate all of the dancers and the different dance halls. The hotel room prices are more reasonable and not as many are required to guarantee the facility price. There is plenty to do in and around the Waco area and many other hotels and restaurants. It's more centrally located in Texas, so the people from Amarillo or El Paso who want to attend will not have to drive as far. While it is not exactly Houston's backyard, it is not an arduous trip.

Even though it will be in Waco (if TSFSRD approves our bid), HSRDC will still be the host for the Friday night event. The Texas Callers Association sponsors the Thursday night dance, the host council sponsors the Friday night event and TSFSRD sponsors all of the Saturday events. What that means is that HSRDC will be responsible for manning the registration booth, will plan the caller line up (working with the President of Houston Caller's Association) and will get the net proceeds from the Friday night dance. It is up to HSRDC if they want to have a "Split the Pot", offer a raffle item or items or do any other types of fundraising.

The Board of Directors for TSFSRD will vote on whether to accept our bid during their meetings at the State Festival in San Marcos, June 6-9, 2013. After the vote, then planning will begin. Volunteers will be needed in many areas, so be thinking about what you want to do to help make the 2016 State Festival a huge success.

Frontier Squares

Frontier Squares was formed in December of 1964 by a group of square dancers who thought the Clear Lake area should have a square dance club. NASA was nearby, so they named the club after the old frontier and the new frontier. The club has danced at the Webster Civic Center, Clear Lake Recreation Center, and Gilruth Center at NASA. TO THE NEW DANCERS

For a new dancer, square dance clothes can seem quite daunting. They are a totally different concept than street wear because they are a costume. The trick to looking good in square dance outfits is getting the proportions right. A skirt that is too short looks like a tutu and one that is too long looks frumpy. A dancer should wear the shortest length that looks good because the longer the skirt, the heavier she will look.

Skirts are usually measured from below the waistband and should match in length to a petticoat measured from top to bottom. This is so you can wear the petticoat at the bottom of the skirt waistband (staggered) and not have all the elastics in one place. This makes the petticoat flush with the bottom of the skirt. You should be able to see the petticoat on the curve but not hanging below the hem of the skirt.

- Blouses should be somewhat loose with plenty of room to move in the shoulders and armholes.
- ♦ A belt will cover the skirt waistband and finish off the outfit.
- If you want to determine your ideal skirt length and size, please feel free to come by Rhythm Creations and I will be glad to spend some time with you and show you how it all works together.

HEARING ASSIST UNITS

A number of clubs, callers and cuers are using hearing-assist systems. These systems consist of a transmitter that's hooked up to the sound system and receivers with ear-bud or ear-speaker worn by dancers. Dancers can purchase the receiver for around \$100.00 to \$160.00 depending on the model. The caller/cuer typically transmits voice signal (this is what most dancers who are hearing-impaired have trouble picking up).

An assistive listening system makes a wireless, electronic connection between the sound source and your ear. This "bridging" effect eliminates the effects of distance, background noise and reverberation so that you can hear and understand better; it's like having the sound source right next to you. If you are in the back of the room, the sound volume can be adjusted at your ear to be as loud as you want, without increasing the loudness of the background noise in the room. Even if the room is noisy or very reverberant, you should still be able to hear clearly, since the listening system is bypassing all the acoustical conditions in the room.
