
#### WHERE N WHEN ASSISTANT EDITOR (ELECTRONIC EDITION)

### NOW IS THE TIME

#### FOR ALL DANCERS TO COME TO THE AID OF THEIR

#### DANCE COMMUNITY

The Third Quarterly meeting is the time for all elected officers for the ensuing year to be elected. These positions are President, 1st and 2nd Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and all District Directors.

The HSRDC Executive board positions of 2nd Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary need dancers to fill these positions. Any member that has served in an elected position in a member club or as District Director of HSRDC and is in good standing with a current club is eligible to hold office. Each office is designed to serve a one year term for each of the offices in succession. This will allow for each office to get acquainted with the responsibilities and duties to better serve its member clubs. Each office has various duties assigned, some according to their title and others as appointed by the present president. The foremost qualification for being an HSRDC officer is the desire to serve its member clubs by: upholding the bylaws, and procedures of HSRDC; supporting club events such as graduations, anniversary dances, specials, etc.; providing leadership and encouragement to all members clubs; and seeking avenues to promote the activity of square dancing, round dancing, and clogging.

The office of District Director is elected by the council. Each member club in their district will submit a recommendation in person or by a letter from the club president to the council for their recommendation. Each office of District Director serves a one year term. As all other officers of HSRDC they should be willing to support the HSRDC and their district clubs. They are expected to support all council events, clubs events, and assist with club support in all matters concerning this dance activity. They must be a member in good standing of a club in their district.

Hunter has been around square dancing all of his life, having been dragged from dance to dance by his grandparents and parents. He met and became friends with many national callers. After the death of his grandfather – his hero – in 2002, Hunter decided that he wanted to do something that would always remind him of his grandfather, and decided to start taking square dance lessons in 2004. A mere four months later he picked up a microphone and began calling.

He is the club caller for the 59ers. In 2008, he revived his grandfather's old club, the Checkerboard Squares. He called his first festival in July of 2007 in California and has also traveled to Japan, Germany and Australia to call and has been staff on land and cruise trips as well.

Hunter is a member of Callerlab and is a member Ways and Means Committee, past Callerlab Liaison for the State of Montana and is the past Chairman of the Youth Committee.

In October of 2007, Hunter attended the 4Dance Caller's Academy in Napa, California with Scot Byars as the instructor. In June of 2008, he also attended the Yellowstone Callers College in West Yellowstone, Montana with Tony Oxendine and Jerry Jestin as the instructors. Both of these callers colleges were made possible by the Bob Mace Memorial Fund Bob Mace was a caller that Hunter grew up around when his parents and grandparents danced. Thank you to that fund for bettering callers.

In 2008, Hunter was honored with a chance to become a recording artist for Royal Records. He recorded his first song, Wild Horses, in October of 2008.

Hunter's influences include, first and foremost, his grandfather, Frank Leenknecht, plus renowned callers Joe Saltel, Jerry Story, Tony Oxendine, Ken Bower, Gary Shoemake, and too many more to name.

Hunter is a ten-year 4-H alumni and an active 4-H leader. Hunter credits almost everything he has learned throughout the past 15 years to 4-H and says that, if it were not for that program, he would not be where he is today. Hunter resides in Billings with his mother, father, brother and grandmother.





## Randy and Maries Preskitt

The Preskitts started dancing in the late 60's with teen square dance clubs in the Seattle area. Randy got behind the microphone as a teen square dance caller in 1971 and got his first club in 1977. They met in 1978 at a Square Dance Jamboree in British Columbia, Canada and were married in 1979. They have made square and round dancing a major part of their lives.

Randy started cueing in the 80's when it became standard for all round dances to be cued. He gave up calling in 1996 to focus all his attention on round dancing. But he just couldn't give up calling forever and now he calls and cues for the Shirts-n-Skirts teen club of which their children have all been members.

Randy and Marie have 2 round dance clubs: The Monday Bunch dancing phase 5 & 6 and the Happy Rounders dancing phase 3 & 4. Both clubs dance at the Hayloft in Lynnwood, Washington.

To date the Preskitts have choreographed numerous dances including Laurann, Beat of Your Heart, I

Got a Girl, Almost Like Being in Love, It's 4 Cha Cha, The Best Is Yet To Come, The More I See You, My First, My Last, My Everything, Dream a Little Dream of Me STS, Recuerdos De L'Alhambra, On Days Like These and a new rumba, Tu Me. Randy and Marie have taught dances and clinics at numerous festivals and weekend dances in British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Ontario, Japan, Germany, Washington, Oregon, California, Missouri, Minnesota, Texas, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, Louisiana, Florida, North Carolina and Washington DC.

In July, 2013, Randy and Marie received the Hall of Fame award for our dance "Beat Of Your Heart" at ICBDA in Reno.

Randy works at the Boeing Company on the new 787 Dreamliner and Marie works at Macy's. They have 3 great children: Leslie 26, Matt 24 and Phil 19. Their children enjoy dancing as much as they do.


