Two Step Round Dance uses the same music as Square Dancing.

There are lots of different styles of 4/4 music.

Generally faster than Cha-Cha, Rumba, and even most Waltz.

There are many ways to divide 4 beats of music.

Two Step uses QQQQ, QQS and SS. Q=quick S=slow.

Learn Figures (Calls) rather than Dances.

If the Cuer announces "TwoStep, Phase 2" get up and dance.

You will be able to dance to most 4/4 music.

I'll teach you some easy sequences as we go.

You will be able to create your own sequences.

About 20 weeks, WITH practice at home, during the week.




